Pre-Layoff Services



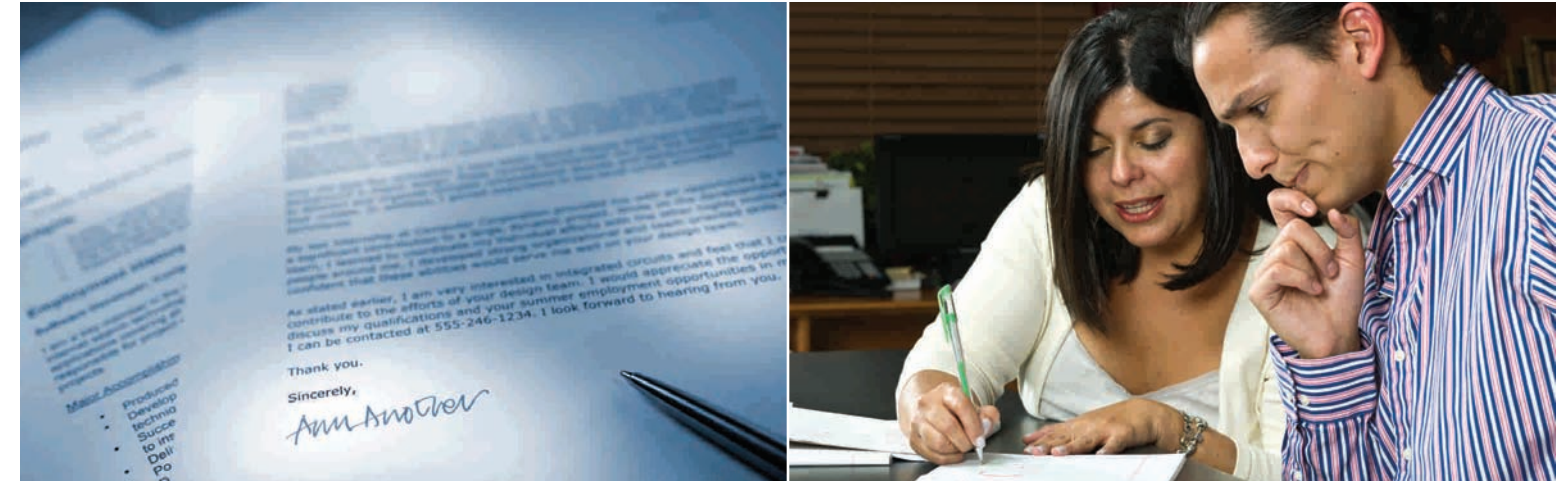
The Dislocated Worker Program's Rapid Response Team – includes partners from WorkSource Portland Metro and from Labor's Community Services Agency – who provide a variety of pre-layoff services at worksites throughout the Portland Metropolitan area. This team "rapidly responds" to requests from the employers and employees, providing information and assistance to those affected by closures and layoffs.

Pre-layoff services include:

- **Information Sessions** — learn what services are available to dislocated workers through the WorkSource system.
- **Unemployment Insurance Information**
- **Labor Market Information** — where are the jobs and what are the hiring trends?
- **Transferable Skills Workshop** — identify the skills you have and learn how to package them to find your next job.
- **Resume Writing Workshop** — we'll show you how to develop a resume that gets you interviews.
- **Interviewing Workshop** — tips and advice on how to prepare to be successful in an interview.
- **iMatchSkills Workshop** — learn how to create a profile that helps you match to quality jobs.

Post-layoff services are tailored to help you get back to work. You can receive these services at one of our WorkSource Centers in the Portland Metropolitan area.
