Training and Services are available for diverse community members living in Washington County or the City of Portland (Sept 2020 – June 2021)

Services are intended to address the impacts of COVID, while supporting long-term equity efforts to increase opportunities for community members who haven't historically had access to good construction jobs. People of color and women are strongly encouraged to apply.

Services will be delivered virtually. Training might include limited in-person activities with strict safety standards.

Eligibility: 18+ years old, high school diploma / GED, receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, interested in a construction career, a resident of Washington County or the City of Portland.

Services are sponsored (no-cost to participants) and may include: **construction career coaching** to connect with pre-apprenticeship training, apprenticeship training and job opportunities; related **support services**; and **pre-apprenticeship training** to earn a credential and build the skills needed to enter a construction apprenticeship program.
